Career Catalyst Scholarship

The Career Catalyst Scholarship is a merit-based award, for new students with a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher, enrolling in a master's degree program at the Keller Graduate School of Management.

Award amount - Master's Degree Level lifetime Award - \$8,000

- Year 1 - \$1,250 per semester, up to \$3,750 per year
- Year 2 - \$1,250 per semester, up to \$3,750 per year
- Year 3 - Up to \$500 per year

Cumulative GPA Requirement: 3.2 on a 4.0 point scale (or 82% on 100 point scale)

Keller Success Scholarship

This merit award provides tuition assistance to new and returning students with a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher, enrolling in a master's degree program at the Keller Graduate School of Management.

Award amount: USD 1,500/year or Master's Degree lifetime award up to \$4,000 (\$500 per semester)

Cumulative GPA Requirement: 2.8 on a 4.0 point scale

Bachelor's Degree

All new undergraduate students with a GPA of 2.0 or above are eligible for awards that can grow along with your grade point average below. And your award can keep growing every year you're in school – up to \$25,000 in tuition savings over the course of enrollment.

- GPA 2.00 USD 3,000/year
- GPA 2.50 USD 6,000/year
- GPA 3.25 USD 7,500/year
