Study Schedule/Delivery Mode

In all of our programs, you will build a timetable which combines 6 hours per week of online study and 14 hours per week of in-class study. The online study component includes exercises, discussion forums, and resources to help with assignments and to provide foundational academic and learning skills.

In-class study schedules combine the core lecture with foundation skills and PASS classes. You must attend both lectures, as each lecture covers different content.

- PASS classes are Practical Assessment Support Sessions. In PASS classes, you will meet with your trainer to discuss any questions you may have about study or assessments.
- Foundation Skills sessions help you build language and other skills for business. You will learn to speak and present ideas with confidence. Topics include running meetings, writing business emails, negotiating and giving presentations.
